Exhibition Eligibility

You must be a paid-up member of Haslemere Art Society to exhibit at the annual exhibition, please ensure this is done before submitting your application.
You must complete all sections of the application form including the availability for stewarding and pay the relevant fees for your application through the website.

We have a cut-off of 50 artists due to the size and space of the room so you are advised to get your entry in early.

Completion of Entry Forms

- Please complete the web-based form and make payment through the website.** This allows the Events Committee to keep track of your application and payments, process the necessary paperwork and produce the labels for your work. It is also the most data-secure and efficient method.

- Should you have any difficulty completing the forms in this way please contact the events team at events@haslemereartsociety.co.uk
- All entries should be submitted by Wednesday 25th September 2024, there are no exceptions to this date.
- Please complete all relevant sections of the form.
- Please ensure that all information you submit on the forms is correctly spelt - the committee will not take responsibility for incorrectly submitted information.
- All fees must be paid before the hand-in date (see below for fee information)

Each artist may submit the following:

- Up to three pieces of ready-to-hang work. No piece should be over 120cm on the longest side. The 3rd piece should be a maximum size 35cm x 35cm.
- Up to three 3D works. Space is limited for displaying these so please be mindful when submitting.
- Up to 5 folio works - mounted work on paper and oil/acrylic on board only (we cannot take wrapped canvases in the browsers)
- Up to 20 art cards

Work we will accept

- All artwork must be original. No copies of original work will be accepted.
- Giclee prints of original work will be accepted however they must be marked a giclee print.
- Prints for hanging or folios need to be one of the following:
 - One-off prints
 - Limited edition with number /qty of the print run
 - Unlimited - marked as this.

Work we will NOT accept

- Work that has been made with a commercially produced kit or design.
- Photocopies
- Commercial photographs

Haslemere Art Society's Right to Refuse

- Any work that does not reach an acceptable standard of presentation
- Any work that does not meet the guidelines set by Haslemere Art Society as detailed in this document.
- In the event of a large number of entries, the committee will ask members to prioritise their work, undisplayed work will be kept to swap in should any work by any artist sell.
- Any oversized work larger than 100 x 100 cm will be considered once all the entries have been received - to ensure all artists are fairly displayed.
- The committee's decision is final.

Stewarding

- Exhibiting members are expected to give a morning 10 - 1.30 pm or afternoon 1.30 - 5 pm session to steward the exhibition - usually in pairs.
- Please indicate on the application form at least 3 dates you are available and a slot will be allocated.
- We have also asked you to indicate if you are available to help on the set-up and take-down days, the committee will be in touch with those who indicate they are available on these days.

Photography

By entering your work you are agreeing to it being featured on all the Haslemere Art Society social media sites and the website to promote the exhibition.
If you have jpeg photographs of the work you are entering we would like to share them on our social media - please send them to by email to info@haslemereartsociety.co.uk in advance of the exhibition.

Financial Matters

- Entry fees:
 - £5 per item for hanging and 3D
 - £3 per folio item
 - Art cards are free to enter
- All sold work, hanging, 3D and folios are subject to a 20% commission and art cards a 10% commission to Haslemere Art Society.
- The commission raised from sales is to support the costs of the exhibition and help fund the other events of the society for the members.
- This will be deducted before sales amounts are paid to you.
- Any uncollected work left with us on Monday 14th October will be subject to a £10 handling fee payable before work is released. The Museum is not responsible for any work left at the venue. If you are unable to collect your work you must arrange for someone to collect it in your place.

Pricing your work

- Please use whole numbers no pence when pricing your work.
- All art cards by the same artist should be priced at the same amount.
- You may enter 1 item marked NFS (not for sale).

Payments for all items

- This year the only payment method we will accept for any items sold (including cards) will be card payment (no cash, cheques or bank transfer). The society has purchased a simple card reader for this purpose and full instructions for use will be provided to those stewarding.

Insurance

- All artists should have the appropriate insurance for their work. Haslemere Art Society or Haslemere Museum do NOT provide insurance for the artwork shown at this exhibition.

Disclaimer

- On delivery of your artwork, you will be asked to sign a disclaimer to agree to the terms and conditions of the exhibition and that the work is left at your own risk.

Presentation of work for hand in:

Hanging Work

All hanging Work should be either framed to a professional standard with taped backs or be a gallery wrapped canvas.
All work should be supplied with D rings and cord for hanging - including gallery wrapped canvasses. Work without D ring and cord will not be accepted.
A luggage tag should be attached to the back of your painting that hangs below the bottom of your work to help the team when hanging. The label should contain the following information.

- Artist Name
- Title
- Price

3D Work

All work should be labelled securely attached to the base of your work.

- Artist Name
- Title of Work
- Price

Folio - work on Paper and boards

Work should be mounted and presented in a cellophane bag to prevent damage.
A label should be attached to the back of the work with:

- Artist Name
- Title of Work
- Price

Art Cards

All cards should be individually wrapped in cellophane and labelled on the back with the following

- Artists name
- Price
