Prizes

Allan Thomson Award:

Voted by Museum staff

Darlah Peters Award:

Voted by the visiting public

The Gallery Thirteen Award:

Chosen by the Committee - a week's exhibition at Gallery Thirteen T&Cs apply.

3D Prize:

Chosen by a creative from the industry.

Submissions

- 4 x hanging works (max 150cm) or
- 3 x 3D works (e.g. sculpture, ceramics)
- Or a combination of 3D and hanging works, with more than 4 works per artist.
- 5 folio works (work or paper, or board, no size limit)

- All work must be original.
- Giclée prints are allowed if labelled as such.

- Not accepted: kits, photocopies or commercial photography.
- We will not be accepting cards this year.

Entry Fees & Commission

- Hanging/3D Under 60cm £5 per item
 - Over 60cm £10 per item
- Folios £3 per item

- Sales commission: 20% (all artwork)
- Card payments only - no cash or cheques
- Late collection (after 22 September) incurs a £10 handling fee.

Presentation Checklist

- All work must be clearly labelled with: Artist Name • Title • Price`

- Hanging work: Framed or gallery-wrapped canvas
 D-rings & cord required for hanging
 Luggage tag label (attached on back, hanging below artwork to be visible on front)

- 3D work: Label securely attached to base

- Folio work: Mounted in cellophane with label on back

- The hanging committee will not accept any work that does not conform to the guidelines or is damaged or is dirty. Work that has been shown in previous years will NOT be hung.

Pricing your work

- Please use pounds only, not pence. e.g. £95. £60 etc
- Please ensure that you have priced your work realistically.

Stewarding

- All exhibitors must steward one shift:
- 10–1.30 pm or 1.30–5 pm
- Indicate 3+ available dates on the entry form.

Extra Help with Exhibition Set Up

- Please indicate on the exhibition entry form if you are interested in helping with set up.

Promotion

- By submitting work, you agree to images of your work being used on Instagram, Facebook, the HAS website and any other public marketing.
- Members will also be asked to promote the exhibition on their social media and email to friends and family with images provided by Haslemere Art Society – physical and digital flyers will be provided
